SOLFA NOTATION-GRADE 2

(Unisa learners only.)

In grade 2 you are going to learn the following solfa notation as well:

- The **compass** is now an octave and not only the first five degrees.
- A note an **octave higher** in solfa notation.
- The **dotted minim** ($^{\circ}$).
- The **crotchet rest** and **minim rest**.
- The **keys** of D and B flat major are added.

A NOTE ONE OCTAVE HIGHER IN SOLFA NOTATION: 1.

To distinguish between the different register placements of a specific solfa syllable, a *number* or *comma* is used as a:

- O Superscript: d¹ or d' to indicate an octave **higher**
- o Subscript: d₁ or d, to indicate an octave **lower**

2. **DOTTED MINIM**:


• You already know that a minim gets **two beats** (two counts). It is indicated by a dash (-):



• A **dotted minim** gets **three beats** (three counts) because it is equal to three crotchets. It is written by two dashes:




3. <u>COMPASS</u>:

The compass of **one octave** will be required for this exam.




4. <u>RESTS</u>:


Rests are indicated by **empty spaces**.


• <u>Crotchet rest – one empty space</u>

• Minim rest – two empty spaces.

Remember, the correct grouping is every beat gets its own rest.






